Our Wisconsin DPI State Report Card went public on Tuesday, November 14. I am happy to say that our District qualifies as a District that “Meets Expectations.” The Report Cards include data on multiple indicators for multiple years across four Priority Areas (Achievement, Growth, Target Group Outcomes, and On-track to Graduation). In addition, the report cards provide course and program participation information for grades 9-12 for public schools and districts. Our District's score of 69.6 puts us in the top three of the eleven Rock Valley Conference Districts behind Edgerton (70.1) and East Troy (70).
