## PARENT REFERENDUM CARDINAL UPDATE - 02/06/25

Dear Brodhead School District Parents:

Both of our Referendums are gaining momentum as we continue pushing out communications about our upcoming April 1 non-recurring 3-year Operational Referendum, while preparing everyone for the start of construction due to the \$17,485,000 Bond (building) Referendum passed last April. I will provide some general information to all of you on both of them as we balance the two Referendums.

## Bond (Building) Referendum Update

We are continuing to prep everyone on this process as the first day of groundbreaking is quickly approaching on March 24. We are in the process of preparing our staff for packing up materials and clearing out areas for initial construction projects. Beginning on March 24, construction will start on the front entrance of the High School, the new 5<sup>th</sup> grade addition at the back of the Middle School, and the new Band room which will be moved from its current location to what is now the Middle School Maintenance area. School entry and parking for the High School will be affected by the High School construction in the front of the school. Communications will be coming out soon regarding where to park after Spring Break and how/where to enter the High School building.

We are starting to receive some great renderings of some of our new spaces as the building design process is getting finalized. Here are some documents containing renderings for each of the new offices in each of our schools as well as some outside renderings for our new High School front entrance, our new 5<sup>th</sup> grade addition at the Middle School, and the new 4K addition at the Elementary School. These new spaces involved a lot of meetings with stakeholders to determine how each of these spaces would look.
