Police Chief Raupp is always on top of any potential issues in our area and we would work together on a communication plan if that were the case. Each situation is different and I make my decisions based on information I have at the time. Student and staff safety is my number one priority and I will communicate with our families if the safety situation affects our District. Thank goodness Brodhead has not had any of these threats.
